RESOLUTION 2009-5: Creation of DBA for MHTA that reflects the intent and purpose of MHTA and creates better correlation between the association's function and the name.

Whereas, the Multi-State Highway Transportation Agreement (MHTA) was created and supported by western states to address common operational and institutional issues concerning highway transportation, and

Whereas, MHTA is seeking to create a better link to the function of the association and its operational name, and

Whereas, MHTA seeks to create a greater regional cooperation and influence on highway transportation issues in the western United States and an operation name for the association that fits its function and goals will assist in that cooperation/influence creation process.

Therefore, MHTA creates a DBA for the association to meet the stated goals above. The DBA for MHTA shall be **Western States Transportation Alliance (WSTA)**. All official correspondence, association communications and forms shall reflect this new DBA. The Executive Director of MHTA shall apply to the State of Colorado to officially file this DBA with the MHTA Corporation filing and communicate this new DBA to all member states, state agencies, industry groups and association participants.
